Starting marks

Usual

The Club's burgee  on the Race Officer's boat, and flag  on a mark.

Caseys Beach

Between the No 6: Caseys Beach mark and the Caseys Beach cardinal mark.

Gate start

A mark with flag  and the Gate Boat's stern.

Course Marks

Each permanent marks is yellow and referred to by a number as follows:

No1: Square Head

No 2: Chain Bay

No 3: Yellow Rock

No 4: Tollgate

No 5: Wimbie Beach

No 6: Caseys Beach

No 7: Marine Park Middle Mark

A laid mark (other than a starting or finishing mark) may be a yellow, orange or pink inflatable mark or as described at the pre-race briefing.

The finishing marks will be the Caseys Beach mark and the West Cardinal mark.

Finish Time and Time limit

A finish time and a time limit will be announced at the pre-race meeting.

Reporting of results

You must record your elapsed time (ie: the time from the **start** [not the warning signal] to your finish) and tell the Handicapper by way of text message to a number announced at the pre-race briefing or an e-mail to: committee@bbsc.org.au. A boat that fails to observe this instruction may be scored DNF.

Shortening, abandoning or changing the course

The person having the power to shorten, abandon or otherwise change the course will be announced at the pre-race meeting.

The person may communicate a decision to shorten, abandon or otherwise change the course:

- (a) by hailing a boat; or
- (b) by radio (VHF Channel 74); or
- (c) if unable to communicate by way of (a) or (b), by phoning a boat on the number provided by the boat's representative at the pre-race meeting.

Start: West of the Middle Mark.

- No 7. Middle Mark (port).
- No 3. Yellow Rock (starboard).
- No 4. Tollgate (starboard).
- No 5. Wimbie (starboard).

Finish: Between the Caseys Beach and West Cardinal marks.

COURSE B. Division 2 Tollgate Classic Approximately 8.5nm.

Start: West of the Middle Mark.

- No 7. Middle Mark (starboard).
- No 5. Wimbie (port)
- No 4. Tollgate (port).
- No 3. Yellow Rock (port).

Finish: Between the Caseys Beach and West Cardinal marks.

COURSE C. Tollgate Classic. The Tri-Star. Approximately 11.5nm.

Start: West of the Middle Mark.

- No 7. Middle Mark (starboard).
- No 4. Tollgate (port).
- No 7. Middle Mark (starboard).
- No.2. Chain Bay (port).
- No 7. Middle Mark (starboard).

Finish: Between the Caseys Beach and West Cardinal marks.

COURSE D. Division 2 Tollgate Classic. Race Officer's Choice.

Flag **L** displayed. Any permanent mark, or a laid mark displayed on a course board. The course board shall reference a permanent mark numerically as set out above and a laid mark as **LM**.

Start: West of the Middle Mark.

As displayed on a course board.

Finish. Between the Caseys Beach and West Cardinal marks.
