Prohibited sailing area

A boat in a race must not pass between a moored boat and the shore.

Penalty: DSQ

Marks

Permanent mark

The helipad's windsock.

Laid marks

A laid mark may be a yellow, orange or pink inflatable mark.

Location

Mark 1: a laid mark in the vicinity of the marina.

Mark 2: a laid mark in the vicinity of the most westerly covered jetty.

Starting marks

The helipad's windsock and a mark located on the Clyde River.

Finishing marks

The helipad's windsock and a mark located on the Clyde River.

BBSC HANDBOOK SECTION 1, PART 10: RIVER WRANGLERS'*Course*

All marks to port.

Start: in the vicinity of the marina.

Marks 2-1-2-1-2.

Finish: in the vicinity of the marina.

Penalty system

The Two-Turns Penalty in rule 44 is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

Shortening the course

If no boat finishes by 1930hrs, the course is shortened to finish at the mark passed by the leading boat at 1930hrs.

Time limits

1930hrs. A boat that fails to finish the course, or the course as shortened, by 1930hrs shall be scored DNF.
