### Caseys Beach Starts





At a pre-race meeting, a member of the Committee may announce that the race shall be a Caseys Beach start and nominate a person on a boat participating in the race to perform the role of Race Officer.

#### *The starting line*

Between the No 6: Caseys Beach mark and the West Cardinal Mark.

#### *Sound signals only*

The race shall be started using only the following sound signals:

<i>Minutes before starting signal</i>	<i>Sound signal</i>	<i>Means</i>
5		Warning signal
4		Preparatory signal
1	 <b>long</b>	One minute to start
0		Starting signal

### Caseys Beach Bay Cup Courses

Division 1 and 2 Bay Cup courses **A**, **B** or **L** read by substituting the words “Finish: Between No 6 Caseys Beach mark and the West Cardinal Mark” for the words:

- No 6. Caseys Beach.

**Finish:** In the vicinity of Snapper Island.
