Sunday 29th October 2017 Safety Day with Peter Walsh

Peter Walsh has confirmed his availability to conduct a safety day 10am to 2pm on Sunday 29th October (the day after the Commodore's dinner) which will include letting off some flares and going out on the river to practice MOB recovery.

Saturday 4th November High Tide 0914 1.59m 'Durras Beagle Bay/Pebbly Beach' Over the Bar by 10.00 am Saturday

Sail to Durras Beagle Bay/Pebbly Beach return and anchor up overnight at Chain Bay, Cullendulla Bay or off Corrigans Beach pending on weather head back to Marina or moorings Sunday after lunch or whenever time suits individual yachts.

Saturday 9th December Low tide 07.50 'Shadow the fleet' - Over the Bar by 10.00/10.30 am Saturday

The coastal races to Broulee would be a combined cruising/racing event. The John Boyes memorial race on December 9th would fit in best with the program. The notion would be for the racing boats to race down to a rounding mark off South Broulee and hence to a finish line off north Broulee. Meanwhile the cruising boats would cruise on down to Broulee and everyone would anchor up afterwards. Those that wanted to stay could anchor overnight either near Broulee Island or Barlings Beach depending on the prevailing conditions then head back the next day. (*)

Saturday 23rd Dec Low tide 0750 0.46 'Christmas Bash' & Club Christmas party - Over the Bar by 10.00/10.30 am Saturday

Join in Non-point score Christmas Cruising Bash and have a sail around Tollgates Black Rock Snapper Island etc! The club also will be holding the ladies skippers race for competitive yachts on this day. Club Christmas party held after at clubhouse.

Saturday January 13th High Tide 0700 1.37m - 'New Year Cruising Holiday Bash' - Over the Bar by 10.00 am Saturday

Sail to Durras Beagle Bay/Pebbly Beach/Merry Beach return and anchor up overnight at Chain Bay, Cullendulla Bay or off / Corrigans Beach pending on weather head back to Marina or moorings Sunday after lunch or whenever time suits individual yachts.

Friday 19th January High tide 10.50am – 1.52m 'Jervis Bay'

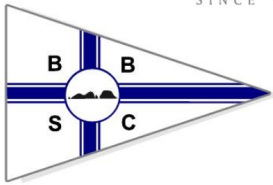
Cruise to Jervis Bay and back around the weekend of Jan 19th to 21 . Cruising yachts may choose to linger a while longer enjoying a few extra days having a daily sail around JB or sail to Crookhaven Bight for the day.

26th January Low Tide 1034. 'Australia Day Classic Barbie Bash' - Over the Bar at 1.00pm

Have a sail to Durras, return and anchor up sausage size on shore and celebrate Australia Day overnight at Chain Bay, Cullendulla Bay or off Corrigans Beach pending on weather then join the fleet the next day.

27th January Low Tide 1151 .037 'Shadow the fleet'

Shadow the racing fleet in Two Bay Classic then anchor up overnight at Chain Bay, Cullendulla Bay or off Corrigans Beach pending on weather head back to Marina or moorings Sunday after lunch or whenever suits individual yachts. (*)



17th February High Tide 1029 1.51m 'Brush Island' - Over the Bar by 10.00 am Saturday

Sail to Brush Island could anchor up overnight behind Brush Island (pending suitable weather) return and anchor up overnight at Chain Bay, Cullendulla Bay or off Corrigan's Beach pending on weather head back to Marina or moorings Sunday after lunch or whenever time suits individual yachts

30th March. High tide 0838 1.57m 'Moruya River'

Moruya River via a lunch stop at Broulee on Good Friday (March 30th). The high tide is in the evening but it is still daylight saving so everyone could get into the river before it was too dark. Yachts who wanted to could head up Moruya River for the markets on the morning of Easter Saturday – there is a cooperative high tide that morning. Could return and anchor at Broulee Island or Barling Beach for Saturday night. (Note end of daylight sailing 1.04.2018)

14th April High Tide 0715 1.43m 'Pebble Beach / Merry Beach' - Over the Bar by 10.00 am Saturday

Sail to Pebble Beach/Merry Beach and return anchor up overnight at Chain Bay, Cullendulla Bay or off Corrigan's Beach pending on weather head back to Marina or moorings Sunday after lunch or whenever time suits individual yachts

19th May High Tide 1155 1.30m – 'Broulee Overnight' - Over the Bar by 10.00 am Saturday

Sail to Broulee overnight anchor up at Broulee or Barlings Beach pending weather and return Sunday after lunch or whenever time suits individual yachts to sail back back to Marina or moorings

Any takers for a Long weekend Bash? 9th June Low tide 1130 0.35m - Over the Bar by 8.30.am

Saturday early start or 1.30pm and catch the early birds on the run back to the Bay. Sail to Pebble Beach/Merry Beach/Brush Island and return anchor up overnight at Chain Bay, Cullendulla Bay or off Corrigan's Beach pending on weather head back to Marina or moorings Sunday after lunch or whenever time suits individual yachts

24th June Low Tide 11.36 0.44 The famous 'Winter Solstice Raft-up' and Club Presentation night

We would be having the presentation night on Saturday June 23rd then the Winter Solstice Raft Up on Sunday June 24th with a venue for the raft up TBA.

28th July High tide 0900 1.18M 'Broulee Overnight' - Over the Bar by 10.00 am Saturday

Sail to Broulee overnight anchor up at Broulee or Barlings Beach pending weather sail back to Marina or moorings Sunday after lunch or whenever time suits individual yachts

25th August High tide 0759 1.17m "Sail the Bay"

Tollgate Island, Black Rock, Jimmies Island, Burrewarra Point return anchor up overnight at Chain Bay, Cullendulla Bay or off Corrigan's Beach pending on weather head back to Marina or moorings Sunday after lunch or whenever time suits individual yachts.

1st and 2nd September 'Fathers Day Picnic'

29th October 1103 1.56m 'Long weekend Cruising Bash' - Over the Bar by 10.00 am Saturday

Sail to Brush Island could anchor up overnight behind Brush Island (pending suitable weather) or return and anchor up overnight at Chain Bay, Cullendulla Bay or off Corrigan's Beach pending weather head back to Marina or moorings Sunday after lunch or whenever time suits individual yachts.
