**BBSC HANDBOOK SECTION 1, PART 10: RIVER WRANGLERS'****Marks***Laid marks - description*

A laid mark may be a yellow, orange or pink inflatable mark.

*Location*

**Mark 1:** a laid mark in the vicinity of the marina.

**Mark 2:** a laid mark in the vicinity of the most westerly covered jetty.

**Mark 3:** a laid mark in the vicinity of the Mariners' jetty.

*Rule 26 start starting marks*

The Club's burgee displayed by the River Wranglers' Race Officer and a mark displaying flag O.

*Handicap starting marks*

The Club's burgee on its flagstaff and a mark displaying flag O on a staff.

*Rule 26 finishing marks*

The Club's burgee displayed by the River Wranglers' Race Officer and a mark displaying flag O.

*Handicap finishing marks*

The Club's burgee on its flagstaff and a mark displaying flag O.

**Starts – rule 26 or a handicap**

The start may be either a rule 26 start with flag Q in lieu of a class flag; **or** a handicap start.

**Rule 26 start locations***Course A*

In the vicinity of the marina.

*Course B*

In the vicinity of the most westerly covered jetty.

**Handicap start locations**

In the vicinity of the marina.

**BBSC HANDBOOK SECTION 1, PART 10: RIVER WRANGLERS'****Handicap start times***Initial start time*

An initial start time for each boat is posted prior to the first race in the series. Starting times for the subsequent races are not posted. You are responsible for keeping track of your accumulated **penalties** and **bonuses** and adjusting your start time accordingly.

*Penalties for 1st, 2nd or 3rd*

A boat that finishes first, second, or third in a race, whether or not it is started subject to rule 26, shall be penalised 4, 3 or 2 minutes, respectively, and her start time for a subsequent race not started subject to rule 26 shall be increased by 4, 3 or 2 minutes, respectively. Each penalty so incurred shall be cumulative.

*Bonuses for 5th, 6th, 7th or below*

A boat that finishes fifth, sixth, seventh or below in a race, whether or not it is started subject to rule 26, shall adjust her start time for a subsequent race not started subject to rule 26 by advancing her starting time by 2, 3, or 4 minutes, respectively, over her time for the race in which she finished fifth, sixth, seventh or below. Each such adjustment shall be cumulative.

**Finishes***Course A*

In the vicinity of the marina, between a blue flag displayed ashore by the Race Officer and a mark displaying flag **O**.

*Course A with a handicap start*

In the vicinity of the marina, between Club burgee on its flagstaff and a mark displaying flag **O**.

*Course B with a rule 26 start*

In the vicinity of the most westerly covered jetty, between a blue flag displayed ashore by the Race Officer and a mark displaying flag **O**.

All marks to port.

**Start:** in the vicinity of the marina.

Marks 3-1-3-1-3.

**Finish:** in the vicinity of the marina.

***Course B***

All marks to port

**Start:** in the vicinity of the most westerly covered jetty.

Marks 1-2-1-2-1.

**Finish:** in the vicinity of the most westerly covered jetty.

**Shortening the course*****In a rule 26 race***

Rule 32 applies.

***In a handicap race***

If no boat has finishes by 1930hrs, the course shall be shortened to finish at the last mark passed by the leading boat as at 1930hrs.

**Time limits**

The time limit is 1930hrs.

A boat that fails to finish the course, or the course as shortened, by 1930hrs shall be scored DNF.

**Penalty system**

The reference to Two-Turns Penalty in rule 44 is replaced by One-Turn Penalty.
